GRADUATE STUDIES

The Master of Education in Educational Technology program requests approval for the following changes:

- A) Allow students filing the official Office of Graduate Studies Degree Plan to select a chair only rather than a three person committee
- B) Allow students to exempt the final exam requirement.

The Master of Education in Educational Technology program was temporarily suspended in Spring 2010 due to the loss of two of the three faculty members in the program. With the use of differential tuition monies, the program will be able to hire an additional clinical faculty person. As such, the program is planning to reopen for the Fall 2013 semester with 20 new enrollees. Additionally, we anticipate enrolling 40 new applicants each year, approximately 20 students at each admission cycle. As the program will have only one tenured faculty member the changes above are necessary to ensure that students are able to move through the program in a timely fashion.
